

REVEIL 2014 3 TO 4 MAY 2014

STREAMS PLAYED IN ORDER BETWEEN 5 AM LONDON TIME ON SATURDAY 3 MAY AND 6 AM LONDON TIME ON SUNDAY 4 MAY

Note: we had a playlist, which was necessarily quite fluid up until the night before the broadcast and even during the first half of the broadcast. This was because the streams would come and go and the quality and interest of streams varied a lot from one listening to the next, depending on the time of day, the weather, technical conditions of the stream and more general conditions such as changes in the season, the migration of animals away from an area, and so on. Often, streams were simply down at the time of the broadcast. On the other hand, some streams seemed almost miraculously to spring into life, or a stream which had never until now been available turned out to be playing, such as the remarkable audio from the wild boar cam in Valencia. During the broadcast, we had one laptop running Nicecast connected to the Wave Farm server, and 3 laptops for capturing the feeds. We would listen to feeds coming up in the playlist and decide which ones to play next. So we whittled down the number of streams in the playlist from around 120 which we had assembled from different sources. We aimed to make smooth simple fades from one stream to the next. After a while, we introduced the stream briefly.
