### SAT 3 MAY

Explore the nature reserve.

Listen in the sound tent to REVEIL: the first live 24 hour broadcast of the sounds of daybreak, relayed by a network of audio streamers around the world.

Highlights include live streams from Austin, TX and Costa Rica by Joel Goodwin; whalesong from Hawaii by the Jupiter Foundation, wild soundscapes with goats and bells by Grégoire Lauvin in the French Pyrenees; and a variety of streams assembled on the Locus Sonus network and elsewhere, many commissioned for this event.

The REVEIL broadcast begins at daybreak on Saturday (London time UTC 0+1) and runs until Sunday morning. There is a limited number of places to camp overnight in the meadow at Stave Hill and listen to the sounds of daybreak in the morning.

Stave Hill is the oldest urban nature reserve in the UK, a successor to the site near Tower Bridge founded by the Trust for Urban Ecology in 1976. The reserve provides habitats for resident and migrant birds including kingfishers and nightingales, and a striking counterpoint to Canary Wharf just across the river.

There will be a hot meal and drinks on Saturday evening, breakfast on Sunday morning and coffee.

Assemble and pitch tents during Saturday.
